WHEREAS Procedure By-law 007-2019, provides that Notices of Motion shall not be discussed or debated upon introduction, but shall be included on the next regular Council meeting agenda for consideration;

AND WHEREAS Section 7.9.3 of the Town of Milton Procedure By-Law 007-2019, as amended, permits a Notice of Motion to be considered upon its introduction by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Members present;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed impractical or not in the best interests of the Town of Milton to delay consideration, particularly since the Canadian Urban Libraries Council ("CULC") Executive hope to finalise the matter before the new Federal government are sworn in (which based on the last Federal election will be prior to the next Town of Milton Council Meeting on 18th November) and with the understanding that most of the

other CULC member libraries have either had the motion passed within their relevant Council or are in the process of doing so; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the pertinent rules contained in Section 7.9 of Procedure By-law 007-2019, be waived to permit the introduction and consideration by Council of the Notice of Motion on the Council agenda pertaining to the endorsement of the Canadian Urban Libraries Council statement with respect to changes to digital loans for public libraries.
