THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MILTON

BY-LAW NO. 085-2019

BEING A BY-LAW TO EXEMPT CERTAIN LANDS FROM PART LOT CONTROL PURSUANT TO SECTION 50 (7) OF THE *PLANNING ACT*, IN RESPECT OF LANDS DESCRIBED AS BLOCK 134, R.P. 20M-1207, IN THE TOWN OF MILTON, REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON (WEST COUNTRY MILTON PROPERTIES LTD.) – FILE PLC-07/19

WHEREAS Section 50 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O 1990, c. P.13, as amended, provides that no person shall convey part of any lot within a Plan of Subdivision;

AND WHEREAS Section 50(7) of the *Planning Act* provides for a Council to designate by by-law that Section 50 does not apply to certain lands within a registered plan of subdivision;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton deems it advisable to enact such a by-law to Block 134, R.P. 20M-1207, from those provisions of the *Planning Act* dealing with part lot control;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Subsection 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act* does not apply to lands described as Block 134, R.P. 20M-1207, and more particularly described in Schedule 'A' attached hereto and forming part of this by-law for the purpose of creating eight (8) townhouse units.
- 2. **THAT** notwithstanding Section 1 of this by-law, this by-law shall expire 365 days from the passing thereof unless the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton has provided an extension by amendment to this by-law prior to its expiry.
