## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MILTON

## BY-LAW NO. 020-2020

BEING A BY-LAW TO EXEMPT CERTAIN LANDS FROM PART LOT CONTROL PURSUANT TO SECTION 50 (7) OF THE *PLANNING ACT*, IN RESPECT OF LANDS DESCRIBED AS BLOCK 237 R.P. 20M-1219, IN THE TOWN OF MILTON, REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON (MATTAMY BROWNRIDGE LIMITED) – FILE PLC-04/20

**WHEREAS** Section 50 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O 1990, c. P.13, as amended, provides that no person shall convey part of any lot within a Plan of Subdivision;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 50(7) of the *Planning Act* provides for a Council to designate by by-law that Section 50 does not apply to certain lands within a registered plan of subdivision;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton deems it advisable to enact such a by-law to exempt Block 237, R.P. 20M-1219; from those provisions of the *Planning Act* dealing with part lot control;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** Subsection 5 of Section 50 of the *Planning Act* does not apply to lands described as exempt Block 237, R.P. 20M-1219; and more particularly described in Schedule 'A' attached hereto and forming part of this by-law for the purpose of creating six (6) townhouse units.
- 2. **THAT** notwithstanding Section 1 of this by-law, this by-law shall expire 365 days from the passing thereof unless the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton has provided an extension by amendment to this by-law prior to its expiry.
