Concerns regarding the application to build more residential houses. My recommendation is to create safe green spaces for the existing residences as the other parks and green spaces are significant walking distances away.
- **Please describe specific actions you want Council to take:**
Reject the application for 12 single detached dwellings and replace them with green space that has a park & playground, Approve the 2 environmental buffer blocks and extension of Whitlock Avenue.
- **Please provide your comments in support of or in opposition to the staff recommendation:**
I support the recommendation from staff to proceed with a community connecting bridge however I am concerned about the lack of green space and play areas for the existing residences. The health benefits of having a safe community with access to green space are insurmountable. Currently, the closest green space/park is the Milton Community Park (over 2km walk) which is forcing this community to walk significant distances to access safe green spaces. The alternative is Raspberry Terrance Park which again is almost 1 km away. There are many young families and children living in this neighbourhood that would benefit from having a safe space to exercise, enjoy nature and facilitate community belonging/inclusion. In addition, green space is fantastic for the environment and is one small but significant step towards combating climate change. I humbly ask for the council to reject the application for 12 additional private residential dwellings and design a community park using the existing space.
