I want council to reject the application as presented as it exceeds the height requirements for the area. I want council to represent the wishes and needs of the citizens of Milton.

I strongly oppose the acceptance of the application for amendment and zoning by-law amendment at 28 60 and 104 Bronte Street North. Current building heights are capped at 6 storeys.
The proposal for 17 and or 18 storeys is unacceptable for the area. These heights of 17 and 18 storeys will have detrimental effects to the current residents of the area, not to mention the effect on the environment.
The proposal of 508 residential units will do little or nothing to combat homelessness as the prices as proposed in the previous submission, was out of the reach of working single people and far too small for working families.
Notwithstanding the current widening of Bronte Street North, the congestion will be detrimental and the increased traffic flow will negatively affect quality of life of Miltonians who call this area home.
