



#### Collisions





# Multi-jurisdictional Task Force Led by HRPS

- Suspects organized & violent, bringing multiple firearms into banks
- Robbed 6 banks in Halton including HH, 40+ in GTA
- Task force worked around the clock for 2 months

# Solved

- March 2020 8 suspects arrested by HRPS (aged 15-23)
- 149 criminal charges laid and 2 loaded firearms seized
- In Halton, 6 bank robberies, 4 retail robberies, 1 car jacking, 1 hit & run, 1 vehicle theft solved

#### Halton Regional Police tout success of robbery task force

8 people arrested and 149 charges laid

A special task force that formed back in January by the Halton Regional Police in response to a dramatic spike in bank robberies across the region — and the GTA — has been deemed a success.

During the Halton Police Board meeting on April 24, Deputy Chief Roger Wilkie said as the result of the Regional Robbery Task Force, police were able to arrest eight individuals, laid 149 charges, and resolved six bank robberies and four retail robberies.

The task force, which is made up of officers from One, Two and Three districts, has also made arrests in three cases of fraud, a carjacking, and "several" vehicle thefts, as well as recovered weapons used in armed robbery cases

"I can tell you that this speaks volumes about the level of engagement that our members are demonstrating, the commitment they have, and the morale to bring people from different districts together in a tight group to work
