## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MILTON

## BY-LAW NO. 114-2021

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF VOTING BY MAIL FOR THE 2022 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

**WHEREAS** subsection 42(1)(b) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, as amended, provides that the council of a local municipality may pass a by-law authorizing electors to use an alternative voting method, such as voting by mail, that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote;

**AND WHEREAS** subsection 42(5) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, as amended, provides that when a by-law authorizing the use of an alternative voting method is in effect, sections 43 (advance vote) and 44 (voting proxies) apply only if the by-law so specifies;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** sections 43 (Advance Votes) and 44 (Voting Proxy) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, as amended, apply to the Town of Milton 2022 Municipal Election.
- 2. **THAT** the use of voting by mail be provided upon request to qualified voters as an alternative voting method that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote at Municipal Elections is hereby authorized.
- 3. **AND THAT** this by-law comes into force and effect on the day it is passed.
