

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MILTON

BY-LAW NO. 115-2021

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF OPTICAL SCANNING VOTE TABULATORS AND TOUCH SCREEN VOTE TABULATORS AT MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS AND TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 074-2006

WHEREAS section 42 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, S.O. 1996, c. 32, as amended, provides that a municipal council may, by by-law, authorize the use of vote counting equipment at municipal elections;

AND WHEREAS Milton Council deems it desirable to pass such a by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton hereby authorizes the use of optical scanning vote tabulators and touch screen vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes at municipal elections.
2. **THAT** this By-law shall come into force and effect upon the date it is passed.
3. **AND THAT** By-law No. 074-2006 is hereby repealed.
