## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MILTON

## BY-LAW NO. 043-2022

BEING A BY-LAW TO STOP UP AND CLOSE PART OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY, BEING A ROAD, BEING PART OF MARY STREET AS ASSUMED BY BY-LAW NO. 16-68, BEING PART OF LOT 1, BLOCK 8, REGISTERED PLAN 15, DESIGNATED AS PART 1 ON PLAN 20R-21074, IN THE TOWN OF MILTON, IN THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON, AND BEING PART OF PIN 24953-0103 (LT)

**WHEREAS,** the *Municipal Act, 2001,* S.O. 2001, as amended, permits the Council of a municipality to pass by-laws for closing and stopping up any highway or part of a highway;

**AND WHEREAS**, it is deemed expedient to stop up and close Part of Mary Street as assumed by By-Law No. 16-68, being Part Of Lot 1, Block 8, Registered Plan 15, Designated As Part 1 On Plan 20R-21074, In The Town Of Milton, In The Regional Municipality Of Halton, and being Part Of Pin 24953-0103 (LT);

**AND WHEREAS,** Section 35 of the *Municipal Act, 2001,* as amended, permits a municipality to pass by-laws removing or restricting the common law right of passage by the public over a highway and the common law right of access to the highway by an owner of land abutting a highway;

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **THAT** part of Mary Street being Part of Lot 1, Block 8, Registered Plan 15, Designated as Part 1 on Plan 20R-21074, in the Town Of Milton, in the Regional Municipality of Halton, and being Part of Pin 24953-0103 (LT), is hereby stopped up and closed for all purposes;
- 2. **AND THAT** this By-law shall take effect on the date of its registration in the Land Titles Office for the Division of Halton (No. 20).
