- **Please describe the issue you intend to present:**  
In light of the climate crisis, conservation of trees should be prioritized over asphalt for parking spaces in new developments. This is a particularly relevant goal when a development is surrounded by a large park, and is an attainable goal when there is already ample parking in the immediate vicinity of a development. Milton has a track record of prioritizing asphalt over trees, and should take action to correct this trend.
- **Please describe specific actions you want Council to take:**  
Council should ensure that the proposed development reflects and respects the present environmental features in and surrounding the site such as mature trees and parkland. In exchange for forcing the development to retain as many existing trees as possible, Council should vote to (1) incorporate the 80 parking spaces present at Sherwood District Park as part of the site's parking minimums (therefore reducing the amount of parking necessary) and (2) connect Sherwood District Park trails with the development so that it has pedestrian access from other than Tremaine Road.
